FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, in the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Budget there were certain capital investment items as follows:




WHEREAS, the Recreation Manager has effectuated a savings of \$10,000.00 in the construction of the above items, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors and Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise desire to enlarge the Apache Service Station and Package Liquor Store located in Whiteriver, Arizona, and construct a Barber Shop and enlarge the said package liquor storage room at a cost of \$10,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is hereby authorized to amend the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Budget by using the unused sum of \$10,000.00 saved in items 3 and 4 above and to construct a Barber Shop adjacent to the Apache Service Station, Whiteriver, Arizona and to enlarge the package liquor storage room located in said Service Station.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

**Dear Mr. Haverland:**

This resolution authorizes the Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise to amend the budget for the current fiscal year. The Manager has made a saving in Item 3, Fencing and Additions to the Store at Smith Park. In Item 4 he also has a savings. I do not know just how much was saved in Items 3 and 4.

I have not received a letter from Standard Oil Company regarding the proposed addition to the service station located at Whiteriver. Mr. Sparks has assured me that a letter of agreement and consent would be forthcoming from the Phoenix Office. I suggest this office be contacted before final approval for amending the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise budget.

This additional space is very necessary and the sales of oil products and gasoline does interfere with the sale of beer and wine. The liquor customers block the front entrance of the service station and gasoline purchasers are use to quick and efficient service and when not served, leave and purchase from the Tribe's competition.

The barber shop is justified and will make money. At the present writing we do not have a feasibility study as to whether a barber shop would be economically feasible. There is no barber shop in Whiteriver, the nearest is at McNary, a distance of 24 miles.

Resolution No. 61-103 was duly adopted on November 1, 1961 by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Tribe's Constitution. Article V, Section 1 (k) requires the approval of the Secretary of the Interior.

It is recommended that this resolution be approved.
