

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe has previously entered into a participating agreement with U. S. Public Health Service regarding the Carrizo water supply and waste disposal facilities, and

WHEREAS, the United States of America, White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Carrizo Indian Community desire to enter into a three-way agreement wherein the Carrizo Indian Community will assume for future maintenance of the said domestic water system and the sewage disposal and refuse disposal facilities.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to execute for and on behalf of the Tribe a Memorandum of Agreement between the United States of America, White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Carrizo Indian Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona. The said agreement in its entirety having been read to the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article 5, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1956, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

**The resolution was adopted on November 2, 1961 by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Tribe's Constitution. As this resolution is not inconsistent with any law, regulation, statute or the Constitution it is not subject to the review or approval by the Secretary of the Interior.**
