WHEREAS, an additional sum of \$1500.00 will be needed to furnish and equip the conference room.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$8,500.00 is hereby appropriated and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$8,500.00 is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury to defray the expenses of office furniture and equipment previously installed and to further defray the expenses of furnishing and equipping the conference room in said office building.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


Dear Mr. Hawley:




