

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 61-105, among other things, directed that Terry Penrod be evicted from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. representatives requested that the Council rescind its action inasmuch as the said Terry Penrod was an excellent worker and did not intend to violate the Tribal Game Laws, and

WHEREAS, the Council is agreeable to rescinding its aforesaid action.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 61-105 is amended by deleting from said resolution the name of Terry Penrod.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Terry Penrod, for a period of seven years from the date hereof, is hereby forbidden to hunt or fish upon the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and the Recreation Manager is directed not to issue him a hunting or fishing license.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Chapter 6, Section 2, Law and Order Code of the Tribe, adopted by the Tribal Council on June 23, 1941 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on June 24, 1941.

Dear Mr. Haverland:

On November 2, 1961 the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe adopted Resolution No. 61-105 evicting a Terry Penrod who was considered a constant violator of the Tribal Game Laws and also State Game Regulations. Said Terry Penrod is an employee of the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., McNary, Arizona, and appeared with the company's personnel manager on December 7 requesting that Mr. Penrod be given another chance to mend his ways and to hold his job with the above-mentioned company.

Resolution No. 61-118 resolves that Resolution No. 61-105 is amended by deleting from said resolution the name of Terry Penrod. The resolution further resolves that Terry Penrod is hereby forbidden to hunt or fish upon the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for a period of seven years.

Resolution No. 61-118 was duly adopted on December 7, 1961 by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Chapter 6, Section 2 of the Tribe's Law and Order Code.
