


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 58-22 authorized the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. to enter into an agreement with the Tribe to have the U. S. Forest Service scale Maverick Logging Unit Timber on the corporation's mill deck at McNary; and by Resolutions No. 61-95 and No. 61-108 the same scaling arrangement was authorized for the Coulter No. 2 Logging Unit and any other units the corporation may contract for in the future on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the corporation has constructed a pulp and paper mill at Snowflake, Arizona that can utilize low grade sawlogs more advantageously for pulp than for lumber, and desires to ship such logs from its Reservation logging units directly to the Snowflake plant where the U. S. Forest Service maintains the same scaling facilities as it does at McNary.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribe be authorized to sign a scaling of logs agreement with the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc.'s present and future timber purchase contracts with the Tribe, said agreement to provide; among other things, that the scaling of logs maybe done in Southwest Forest Industries, Inc.'s plants located at McNary and Snowflake, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

The White Mountain Apache Tribe entered into an agreement to have the U. S. Forest Service scale Maverick Unit timber on the mill deck at McNary and also has the same scale arrangements for the Coulter No. 2 Logging Unit. Resolution No. 61-122 will authorize the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. to ship low grade saw logs directly to its pulp and paper mill at Snowflake, Arizona. It also authorizes the U. S. Forest Service to scale these low grade logs at the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. pulp and paper mill at Snowflake. The Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council are authorized to sign a scaling of logs agreement with Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. at their plants at McNary and Snowflake.

Resolution No. 61-122 was duly adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Tribe's Constitution. This resolution is not subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior.
