

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, McNeil Toggie has been the Janitor at Alchesay Hall, General Livestock Office, Recreation Enterprise Office and Tribal Council Office, and

WHEREAS, there has been added to the janitorial services the Tribal Disbursing Office, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to increase his salary.

BE IT RESOLVED that the salary of Janitor, McNeil Toggie be increased at the rate of \$600.00 a year beginning January 1, 1962.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Budget be modified to provide for the additional compensation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said McNeil Toggie be given two weeks vacation with pay each year.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

The present tribal janitor maintains the present tribal office, Alchessay Hall, and Recreation Enterprise office for a yearly salary of \$2,400, as provided in Section 5(a), Tribal Resolution No. 61-39. The Tribal Council desires to increase his salary by \$600 per year which would be adequate compensation for the additional work load caused by the additional responsibility for the new tribal business office consisting of a Council meeting room, two large lavatories, a long hall and a five desk office with a total of 1,900 square feet of floor space.

Resolution No. 61-127 resolves that the salary of Janitor McNeil Toggie be increased by \$600 per year beginning January 1, 1962.

This resolution was duly adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Tribe's Constitution.

It is recommended that the tribal budget be modified to provide for the additional compensation.
