

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees and Board of Education of the Elementary School District No. 20 and Alchesay High School respectively, establish the position of Attendance Officer for such School District, and

WHEREAS, in order to protect said office and to give him the powers of a Police Officer,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency commission the duly appointed Attendance Officer of the Elementary School District No. 20 and Alchesay High School District, White Mountain Apache Tribal Police.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Criminal Investigator of the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby requested to assist the said Attendance Officer in securing a commission as a qualified Deputy Sheriff of Navajo County.

The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
