

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council appropriated funds for juniper eradication in the Canyon Day District, and

WHEREAS, the community of Canyon Day has petitioned the Council to transfer said funds to their water repair and development program.

BE IT RESOLVED that monies appropriated for Fiscal Year 1962 in the amount of \$6,650.00 (62-15 (j), Section 1, Tribal Budget, White Mountain Apache Tribe) is transferred to 62-86 (d), Section 9, Canyon Day Water System Repair.

The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
