

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the below named timber contracts have expired on December 31, 1961:

1. Coulter No. 1 Logging Unit, Whiting Brothers Land and Timber Company, contractor.
2. Highway 60 Right-of-Way Logging Unit, Reidhead and Chlarson, contractor, and

WHEREAS, slash burning requirements were not performed due to early heavy snows on the contract areas.

BE IT RESOLVED that the above-mentioned contractors be given time extensions to December 31, 1962 to comply with all of the conditions of the contracts.

The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
