

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Paragraph 3, Section 2, of Ordinance No. 20 provides that the Superintendent or his authorized representative is empowered to issue peddlers' permits until such time as the Council may desire to authorize a Bonded Officer to issue them, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to authorize the Tribal Treasurer who is a Bonded Officer to issue said permits.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Paul Simmons, the Tribe's Bonded Tribal Treasurer, be hereafter authorized to issue peddlers' permits on the reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said permits be co-signed by either the Chairman or the Vice-Chairman of the Tribal Council.

The Foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (o) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
