

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Limestone Logging Unit, under Contract to Chlarson-Reidhead Logging Company, approved October 8, 1958, was originally to have completed its timber cutting on December 31, 1960, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 60-85, October 27, 1960, an extension of time was granted which provided that cutting was to be completed on December 31, 1961 and slash and snag disposal by December 31, 1962, and

WHEREAS, on December 5, 1961 by letter this Company states that due to adverse weather and market conditions they will require until October 31, 1962 to complete cutting and until December 31, 1962 to complete slash and snag disposal on this unit.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chlarson-Reidhead Logging Company be granted the following time extension to complete the terms of the Limestone Logging Unit Contract: cutting of timber to October 31, 1962, and slash and snag disposal and other obligations, to December 31, 1962.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as a condition precedent to the granting of this extension becoming effective, the Chlarson-Reidhead Lumber Company is to reopen the Carrizo Mill, located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, within two weeks from the effective date of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as a condition precedent to this resolution becoming effective, the Chlarson-Reidhead Lumber Company does not haul any logs off the reservation to be milled.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
