

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1962, pursuant to Resolution No. 61-105, the Tribal Council evicted Terry Penrod, Luther Stingley, Jean Stingley, Robert (Bobby) Tobin, Willie Acker and Mack Holloman from the reservation for the reason that said men had been guilty of committing misdemeanors on the reservation.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 61-118 the Tribal Council amended said Resolution No. 61-105 and permitted Terry Penrod to remain on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Area Director has advised the Tribal Council that the authority quoted in said Resolution No. 61-105 was in error.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 61-105 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Luther Stingley, Jean Stingley, Robert (Bobby) Tobin, Willie Acker and Mack Holloman be forcibly evicted from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and forever estopped from returning thereto.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
