WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, certain Livestock Associations desire to purchase cattle off the reservation, and


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council that all livestock on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation retain their high quality.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Clinton Kessay, Rufus Altaha, Robert E. Robinson and Stanley Wright are hereby appointed on the Committee to be here and after known as the Cattle Inspection Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Committee is hereby authorized and directed to inspect and approve all cattle to be purchased off the reservation for use on the reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the same Livestock Board is hereby requested to furnish the necessary traveling expenses incurred by said Committee in inspecting and approving said cattle purchases.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
