

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Central Office has notified the Superintendent that any time that women prisoners are incarcerated in the Tribal Jail that there must be women matrons on duty at all times, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in order to continue an efficient police force that the Law and Order Budget be increased.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Law and Order Budget, Section III, (d) Salaries of Policemen plus Taxes and Insurance, is hereby amended by appropriating an additional sum of \$1439.00 from Tribal Funds on Deposit in the United States Treasury to defray the salary of an extra officer until the first day of July, 1962.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
