

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a line of credit for the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the amount of \$4,000,000.00 has been approved by the Central Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has made application for the sum of \$700,000.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said line of credit the Tribe had requested as its second priority the sum of \$700,000.00 for relending to Tribal members for construction of homes and other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED that an advancement in the sum of \$700,000.00 is hereby requested under said master loan agreement to be used for relending to Tribal members for housing construction and other purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute any and all necessary documents for and on behalf of the Tribe to effectuate said loan with the United States Government.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
