

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Welfare officials, because of depressed winter conditions on the Reservation, have had to expend more than was anticipated for food and other welfare programs.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Welfare Budget, Section IV (a) is hereby amended by appropriating an additional sum of \$7,150.00 from Tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasurer to defray the additional costs of food, clothing and other welfare programs due to the depressed conditions on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
