

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED that the Jump-Off No. 1 Logging Unit of 5,623 timbered acres with an estimated volume to be cut of 14,334,000 board feet be advertised for sale under the following conditions:

- a. That the minimum advertised rates per M. feet, B. M. shall not be less than \$9.00 for ponderosa and white pines; \$5.20 for Douglas fir, and \$3.00 for white fir;
- b. That the minimum stumpage rates per M feet B. M. shall in no event be reduced below \$6.50 for ponderosa and white pines; \$3.50 for Douglas fir and \$2.50 for white fir;
- c. That the advertising of this unit shall be paid from Tribal funds Account 62-66;
- d. That the contract as attached hereto is approved subject to such changes as may be deemed necessary by the Area Director;
- e. That the Tribal Council requests that this timber be sold by sealed bids, followed by oral auction as set forth by the advertisement;
- f. That the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council be authorized to execute the contract and any necessary extensions or modifications for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the net proceeds from the sale of timber on this unit be deposited to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 62-20 of March 7, 1962 be rescinded and the foregoing resolution be substituted in its place.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
