

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 58-39, September 3, 1958 authorized the sale of oak timber from the North Fork Oak Logging Unit, from which Units No. 1,2,3,4 and 5 have been sold and,

WHEREAS, Unit No. 6 has been appraised and reviewed by the Area Director on March 6, 1962 and recommends that 1,000 cords be advertised at the minimum price of \$2.75 per cord.

BE IT RESOLVED that the North Fork Oak No. 6 Logging Unit be advertised in accordance with regulations for two weeks at the minimum price stated above and that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign a contract covering sale of said timber.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any contractor awarded an Oak Logging Contract should be required to clean up the limbs, waste wood, etc.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
