

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the East Fork No. 1 B Logging Unit of the Tribal Sawmill Block has been appraised for logging by the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company; the unit contains 13,685 MBF of sawlogs on 4,623 timbered acres,


BE IT RESOLVED that the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company contract with the Tribe for the above mentioned unit and that the stumpage rates for sawlogs per MBF based on the Western Pine Association index prices of lumber and adjusted quarterly pursuant to said Western Pine Association index prices.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the minimum stumpage rates shall in no event be reduced below the following: ponderosa and Mexican white pine, \$6.50; Douglas fir, \$3.50; spruce, \$3.50; White fir and other species, \$2.50.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract attached hereto is approved subject to such changes as may be deemed necessary by the Area Director.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Council be authorized to execute the contract and any necessary extensions or modifications for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
