

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, in order to give adequate police protection to Whiteriver and adjoining areas it is necessary to employ a night patrolman.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a position of night patrolman, Grade GS-5 (Civil Service) be established and that the position be filled by existing Bureau of Indian Affairs personnel or from a register of Civil Service eligibles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary and expenses of this position be paid from appropriate tribal funds.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
