

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the increase in administrative responsibilities of the tribal office over the last two years has resulted in a steady rise of the duties and administrative responsibilities of the Vice Chairman, and

WHEREAS, the Vice Chairman in the absence of the Council Chairman has the full responsibility and duties of the Tribal Administrative Office, and

WHEREAS, the present Vice Chairman has the full responsibility of Athletic Director and charged with a full time position, and

WHEREAS, a review of the present duties and responsibilities of the Vice Chairman's position show that an adjustment is in order.

BE IT RESOLVED that the combined position of Vice Chairman and Athletic Director for the White Mountain Apache Tribe be increased from the equivalent of GS-5(a), \$4,345 per annum to the equivalent of GS-7(a), \$5,355 per annum plus employer's share of the taxes and premiums retroactive to July 1, 1962.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that he shall receive 15 days annual leave per year and 15 days sick leave per year; and step increases and Congressional raises be included.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 2, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it Article V, Section 1 (i), (k) and (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1943 (48 Stat. 984).
