proceed post-haste in effectuating the West Block
timber sales.

in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution

and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that Albert M. Hawley, Fort Apache Agency Superintendent, Barry De Rose, Tribal Attorney, Lester Oliver, Chairman and Fred Banashley, Vice-Chairman, be delegated to represent the Tribal Council at Washington, D. C. during the latter part of July and/or the first part of August, 1962.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the itemized statement of objectives to be accomplished in Washington are attached hereto and made a part of this resolution.
