

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the enabling paragraphs of TR 62-40 allow the Tribal Treasurer to accept only the signatures of legally delegated employees to authorize payments from funds in his custody, and

WHEREAS, disbursements from Agency Accounts 2224.1 which fall within the provisions of 42 IAM (Phoenix Area Office) 603.03E(19) (b) 2-d BF-6 (March 5, 1956) also allow the Superintendent to accept only the signatures of properly designated tribal employees to authorize payment of vouchers from funds within his custody.

BE IT RESOLVED that either the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Acting Secretary, Recreation Manager or Construction Manager be duly authorized to sign vouchers to cause payment by the Treasurer and/or Superintendent from the following assigned sections of the Budget:

Tribal Council Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary or Assistant Secretary, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 10.

Recreation Manager, Section 8

Construction Manager, Section 9 and 11.

The foregoing resolution was on July 2, 1962 dully adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1, (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
