

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Sports Fisheries and Wildlife of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, hereinafter referred to as the Bureau, has requested the Tribe to enter into an amendment to agreement dated December 26, 1961, regarding the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery, and

WHEREAS, the amendment will work to the mutual benefit of the Tribe and the Bureau.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign an amendment to the agreement between the Tribe and the Bureau dated December 26, 1961, regarding the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery, by adding the following:

The Tribe will assist the Bureau in the operation of the Williams Creek National Fish hatchery by furnishing such labor or other assistance as may be mutually agreed from time to time between the Tribe and the Bureau.

All other provisions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on July 2, 1962 duly adopted by a vote 10 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
