

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FONT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution 60-83 authorized the hiring of a tribal credit clerk, Mrs. Genevieve B. Truax, whose duties included keeping the books and records of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Herd and the Tribal Short Term Loan Program, and

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution 60-83 authorized the payment of the salary of the clerk from tribal credit funds, and

WHEREAS, the Area Office Budget letter dated January 25, 1961 approved said Resolution; and


WHEREAS, the salary therefor was paid from funds of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Herd for the period January 22, 1961, through June 22, 1962, and


WHEREAS, the Manager of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Herd requests reimbursement of one half of the salary paid to said clerk, said one half amounting to \$2,472.89, which is considered to be the proportionate share of clerical time spent in performing the duties of each fund involved.

BE IT RESOLVED that Tribal Resolution 60-83 is hereby amended to allow the said clerk to be paid one half from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Herd fund and one half from the Tribal Revolving Credit Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Herd Enterprise be reimbursed the sum of \$2,472.89 for the overpayment as heretofore provided.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted by a vote of 10 for 0 against on August 1, 1962, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
