

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal construction program will be more effectively operated if a Board of Directors is appointed to supervise activities of the manager of the program, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to assume the responsibility of the "Self-Help Housing Program" in the Canyon Day area.

BE IT RESOLVED that Fred Danashley, Pachel Johnson, and Edgar Kahn are ordered to represent the Tribal Council and to assume full liability for the construction of homes under the "Self-Help Housing Program" at Canyon Day.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1962, duly adopted by a vote 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
