

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Tribal Resolution No. 62-24, J. H. Webb, was ordered to remove his machinery and mill from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the planing mill is not now receiving sufficient logs to insure the maximum production from said planing mill.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 62-24 is amended to permit J. H. Webb to again saw logs on the Reservation at his East Fork sawmill.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Noble Johnston, Manager of Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, and Lester Oliver, Chairman of the Tribe, are authorized to negotiate a contract with J. H. Webb to saw timber for the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Webb's financial responsibility be satisfactory to the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency prior to any contract being signed by Lester Oliver for and on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
