

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Western States Telephone Company, Inc., has requested a right of way on certain lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to construct a micro-wave tower and central office building, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe will be benefitted by having more efficient telephone service and by receiving damages for the use of the said lands located at Smith Park.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and/or the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency be authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to grant a right of way to the Western States Telephone Company, Inc., to construct a micro-wave tower, central office building, and associated equipment in order to establish dial telephone service in the Smith Park area on lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation. The plat of said land, covering a tract 100 feet by 100 feet, being on file in the office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency to which reference is hereby made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the right of way shall be for a term of ten years, and shall be subject to renewal for a like term upon compliance with the applicable tribal and federal regulations, beginning the 1st day of September, 1962.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Western States Telephone Company, Inc., shall pay as and for damages of the use of said land a sum not less than the appraised value as determined by the Phoenix Area Office. The damages will be payable in advance on or before the 1st day of September, 1962 and on the same date yearly thereafter for the term of the right of way.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
