

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department desires to obtain sand and gravel for the purpose of highway maintenance and construction on the Globe-Show Low Highway, and

WHEREAS, it is economically beneficial to the Tribe to sell said sand and gravel.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Arizona Highway Department be granted a permit to remove sand and gravel from a material site lying within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, 300' left of Station 766+00 on the Globe-Show Low Highway, Gila County, and being more particularly described in the sand and gravel permit dated the 1st day of August, 1962 by and between the Tribal Council, Permitter, and the Arizona Highway Department, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arizona Highway Department pay the Tribe the following amounts, computed on a tonnage basis, for the removal of road construction materials: 3 cents per ton for all Borrow, 6 cents per ton for all Select, ABC, MA, and 10 cents per ton for all Screenings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to sign said permit for and on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
