

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there have been innumerable complaints because of the many rodeos being conducted by individuals at the fair grounds, and

WHEREAS, rodeos are a means of income for the respective community clubs.

BE IT RESOLVED that no individuals hereafter will be permitted to use the fair grounds for rodeos until they first have the approval of the community club in the district in which they reside and the approval of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
