WHEREAS, during his tenure as U. S. Senator, he has been a great friend and benefactor of the White Mountain Apaches, and
WHEREAS, the Council desires to in some way show its appreciation to this great leader.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman appoint a committee to dedicate the Alchesay Fish Hatchery.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to defray the expenses to conduct a free barbecue at said dedication.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that venison and/or elk be furnished by the Tribe for barbecuing at said dedication.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the dedication be in honor of U. S. Senator Carl Hayden.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
