


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation desires to be granted permission from the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to carry out surveys and investigations on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, said surveys could be beneficial to the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Reclamation is hereby authorized and permitted to have access to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for carrying out surveys and investigations relating only to hydrologic and engineering studies for the development of dams, reservoirs, waterways and appurtenant works.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
