

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is now in the construction business, and

WHEREAS, unlicensed contractors are performing inferior work on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that no person, firm or corporation shall erect, construct, alter, repair, move, improve, remove, convert or demolish any building or structure on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation or cause the same to be done without first obtaining a separate building permit for each such building or structure from the Construction Manager of the Tribe and the Tribal Chairman or Vice Chairman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no license shall be issued to any person, firm, partnership, corporation, association or other organization, or a combination of any of them, to engage in the business, act or offer to act in the capacity, or purport to have the capacity of contractor on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation without first having an Arizona State license as prescribed by the laws of the State of Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall not apply to any authorized representative of the United States Government or White Mountain Apaches who are sole owners of property, building or improving structures thereon for the use and occupancy of such owners and their families and not intended for sale, or the construction, alteration, improvement or repair of personally owned property.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
