

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, to properly administer the Revolving Credit Program heretofore established by the Tribal Council, a Bookkeeper-Stenographer is needed to replace Mrs. Genevieve B. Truax who resigned, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Credit Committee at a meeting on August 23, 1962, passed Resolution No. 63-4 recommending that the vacant position be filled, and

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 60-83 passed October 27, 1960, established and authorized this position.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Yvonne Alchesay be hired to fill the position of Credit Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary, equivalent to Civil Service Grade GS-3, and the expenses of this position be paid from Tribal Revolving Credit Funds or Tribal Herd Enterprise funds or from both as may be agreed upon by the Credit Officer and Tribal Herd Enterprise Manager for the balance of this fiscal year and for each succeeding year thereafter.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
