RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Lutheran Church has requested a revokable permit covering the premises now occupied by their Church at Fort Apache, Cedar Creek and McNary areas of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent is authorized and directed to issue a revokable permit to the Lutheran Church covering the areas in the Fort Apache, Cedar Creek and McNary areas as per the map on file at the Fort Apache Agency to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
