

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Lutheran Church has requested a revokable permit for approximately 24 acres of land located in the East Fork Area, Fort Apache Indian Reservation which is now being used by said Lutheran Church.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent is requested and directed to issue a revokable permit to the Lutheran Church for approximately 24 acres of ground located in the East Fork Area as per the map on file at the Fort Apache Agency to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
