

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department has requested a revocable permit covering certain lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for the use of the Indian Pine Maintenance Camp, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe will be benefited by the maintenance camp and by receiving damages for the use of the said lands located at Indian Pine Junction.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and/or the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency be authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to grant a revocable permit to the Arizona Highway Department for the lands occupied by the Indian Pine Department for the lands occupied by the Indian Pine Maintenance Camp. The plat of said land, covering a tract 250 feet by 400 feet, 2.02 acres, being on file in the office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency to which reference is hereby made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the revocable permit shall be for a term of 4 years and 10 months, retroactive from 11/1/58 through 8/31/63; and will be merely an interim permit pending the selection and lease of a new site as requested by the Phoenix Area Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arizona Highway Department shall pay as and for damages of the use of said land the sum of \$150.22 computed at \$25.00 per year for 3 years and 10 months, 11/1/58 through 8/31/62 (less payment of \$14.58 on 7/31/58), and 1 year, effective 9/1/62, @ \$69.00, the appraised value.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
