

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mountain Air Taxi Service has requested permission to use the Whiteriver Airport facilities, and

WHEREAS, it would be of benefit to the Tribe to grant such permission.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mountain Air Taxi Service is hereby granted permission to use the Airport facilities at Whiteriver, Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribe and the individual members thereof will not be responsible for any liabilities due to the use of the Airport by the said Mountain Air Taxi Service.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
