FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a need for additional recreational activities on the reservation, and


WHEREAS, the Criminal Investigator and the Tribal Police are desirous of sponsoring boxing and wrestling matches at Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Police Department will be allowed the use of Alchesay Hall for such activities, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all funds realized from such events shall be deposited in the Athletic Account of the Tribal Accounting Office, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said funds shall be used to further recreational activities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and shall be dispensed by the Tribal Treasurer as are all other athletic funds now being dispensed.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
