

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Diamond Creek No. 2 Logging Unit of 1,747 acres to be logged with an estimated volume to be cut of 14,330,000 board feet of sawlogs be sold to the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, a tribal enterprise, under the following conditions:

- a. That the appraised rates per M feet B.M. as recommended by the Area Director on September 27, 1962 be approved as follows: Ponderosa and Mexican White Pine, \$19.30; Douglas Fir, \$7.00; White Fir, \$3.00; Spruce and Corkbark Fir, \$10.00;
- b. That the minimum stumpage rates per M feet B.M. shall in no event be reduced below \$6.50 for Ponderosa and Mexican White Pine; \$5.00 for Douglas Fir; \$2.50 for White Fir and \$3.50 for Spruce and Corkbark Fir;
- c. That the contract attached hereto is approved subject to such changes as may be deemed necessary by the Area Director;
- d. That the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council be authorized to execute the contract and any necessary extensions or modifications for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the net proceeds from the sale of timber on this unit be deposited to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on October 12, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
