


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED that H. L. Barnett and Melvin E. Toney, Contractors of the North Fork Oak No. 6 Logging Unit be authorized to cut oak railroad ties from this unit in conjunction with the harvesting of converter poles provided that the price paid for tie logs be the same as for converter poles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that H. L. Barnett and Melvin E. Toney, Contractors for the North Fork Oak No. 6 Logging Unit be authorized to locate a portable sawmill within the above mentioned logging unit.

The foregoing resolution was on November 8, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
