


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Canyon Creek No. 1 Logging Unit Contract, approved July 17, 1962, Western Lumber and Moulding Company, Contractor, has cut approximately two million of the required four million board foot quota for the year 1962, and

WHEREAS, it was delayed for some time in obtaining a right of way on the Sitgreaves National Forest and was also delayed by the summer rains on the steep roads of this unit making it impossible to meet the cutting requirement and therefore has on the date of October 26, 1962, requested relief.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Contractor be relieved from cutting the specified four million board feet in 1962 and that it add the uncut balance to its 1963 cutting requirement in accordance with Section 6. (a) (1) of the Standard Contract Provisions.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
