

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Hawley Lake Road Right of way Logging Unit has been appraised for the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, and contains 364,650 board feet of sawlogs on 62.6 acres of timbered land.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company contract with the Tribe for the above-mentioned unit under the following conditions:

- a. That the stumpage rates per M feet BM for sawlogs as approved by the Area Director on November 27, 1962 be as follows: Ponderosa and Mexican white pines, \$9.05; Douglas fir, \$16.00; Spruce and white fir, \$4.10;
- b. That the contract attached hereto be approved subject to such changes as may be deemed necessary by the Area Director;
- c. That the Chairman and Secretary of the Council be authorized to execute the contract and any necessary extensions or modifications for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe;
- d. That the Chairman and Secretary of the Council and the Manager of Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company be authorized to contract for logging and milling services for this timber, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the net proceeds from the sale of the timber on this unit be deposited to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
