

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the salary for the position of tribal janitor was not included in the Maintenance Section of the FY 1962-63 Budget after being deleted from the Athletic Section, and

WHEREAS, some tribal positions are set up on a basis "as equivalent to comparable Civil Service Grades" including all benefits except retirement and insurance, more funds will be needed to provide increases matching those granted by Congress for Government employees effective October 14, 1962.

BE IT RESOLVED that all activities receiving service from the Tribal Business Office shall be billed monthly for their proportionate share as per Section II of TR 62-40 to provide the funds necessary to cover the above listed obligations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 61-127 adopted on December 7, 1961 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that McNeil Toggie be employed as Janitor only at Alchessay Hall at the salary rate of \$2,400 per annum plus taxes and that an additional part time janitor be employed at the new tribal offices at the rate of \$600 per annum plus taxes, which is the amount of salary increase given to Mr. Toggie in Resolution No. 61-127.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Budget for Fiscal Year 1963 be amended by appropriating the sum of \$2,373.20 to cover the equivalent status raises under Section I - COUNCIL - Item b-1 and Item d-1; SECTION II - BUSINESS OFFICE - Items a thru g; SECTION V - COMMUNITY PROGRAMS - Item a; SECTION VI - FORESTRY - Items a thru c; and SECTION XI - MAINTENANCE & CONSTRUCTION - Item a-6.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that SECTION XI - MAINTENANCE & CONSTRUCTION, Subsection (b) be amended in the amount of \$3,208.92 to cover the salaries of the tribal janitors.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE

WHEREAS, the salary for the position of tribal janitor was not included in the Maintenance Section of the FY 1962-63 Budget after being deleted from the Athletic Section, and

WHEREAS, some tribal positions are set up on a basis "as equivalent to comparable Civil Service Grades" including all benefits except retirement and insurance, more funds will be needed to provide increases matching those granted by Congress for Government employees effective October 14, 1962.

BE IT RESOLVED that all activities receiving service from the Tribal Business Office shall be billed monthly for their proportionate share as per Section II of TR 62-40 to provide the funds necessary to cover the above listed obligations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 61-127 adopted on December 7, 1961 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that McNeil Toggie be employed as Janitor only at Alchesay Hall at the salary rate of \$2,400 per annum plus taxes and that an additional part time janitor be employed at the new tribal offices at the rate of \$600 per annum plus taxes, which is the amount of salary increase given to Mr. Toggie in Resolution No. 61-127.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Budget for Fiscal Year 1963 be amended by appropriating the sum of \$2,373.20 to cover the equivalent status raises under Section I - COUNCIL - Item b-1 and Item d-1; SECTION II - BUSINESS OFFICE - Items a thru g; SECTION V - COMMUNITY PROGRAMS - Item a; SECTION VI - FORESTRY - Items a thru c; and SECTION XI - MAINTENANCE & CONSTRUCTION - Item a-6.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that SECTION XI - MAINTENANCE & CONSTRUCTION, Subsection (b) be amended in the amount of \$3,208.92 to cover the salaries of the tribal janitors.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1956, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
