WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is desirous of furnishing to its low-income families, adequate housing, and


WHEREAS, the Federal Housing Administration has expressed an interest in assisting the Tribe in establishing the White Mountain Tribal Housing Authority and securing financing for same, and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 45a, the Tribe chartered a public corporation concern as the White Mountain Tribal Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Housing Administration has advised the Tribe that this Ordinance does not comply with its requirements.

BE IT RESOLVED that Proposed Ordinance No. 47 is hereby ordered to be posted for the required legal ten-day period.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
