

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Declaration of Policies and Plan of Operation, Credit Program, White Mountain Apache Tribe, approved January, 1961, has become outmoded because of changes in the regulations of the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Credit needs of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council and the Credit Committee to liberalize and expand the credit program to accelerate the social, educational and economic advancement of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the attached Declaration of Policies and Plan of Operation is hereby adopted and is to become effective immediately upon the approval of the Secretary of the Interior or his duly authorized representative.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (i) and (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
