

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 62-78, Paschal and Alutha Johnson, husband and wife, applied for a homesite lease in the vicinity of Seven-Mile, and

WHEREAS, they have submitted a rough sketch of the tract of land upon which they wish to build a house, and


WHEREAS, said Resolution No. 62-78 provided for a lease of ten years with a renewal option of ten years, and

WHEREAS, the tribe desires to grant a twenty-five (25) year lease with a renewal option of five (5) years.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Council are hereby authorized to approve and grant a homesite lease to Paschal and Alutha Johnson for a period of twenty-five (25) years with a renewal option of five (5) years at a yearly rental of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) payable in advance on the first day of January, 1963, with an annual payment of a like amount on the same date each year thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 62-78 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on December 27, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
