

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on August 14, 1962 the Master Forest Management Plan for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation was transmitted to Washington for the Commissioner's approval, and

WHEREAS, on date of November 30, 1962 the Chief, Branch of Forestry has recommended approval to the Commissioner and requests that the Tribal Council approve the plan by resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Master Forest Management Plan of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona, 1961, prepared by the Branch of Forestry, Fort Apache Indian Agency under the direction of C. R. Patrie, Area Forester as submitted to the Commissioner on August 14, 1962 be approved, subject to review at any time by the Tribal Council with the right to make recommendations for changes and/or modifications as is deemed necessary.

The foregoing resolution was on January 16, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
