

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company will contract for logging and log delivery services from various logging units contracted for by the company with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, such services will be for a three year period for a minimum of 60 million board feet per year at a firm price for each unit for the period or duration of each unit, and

WHEREAS, seven qualified loggers have inspected the logging areas planned and have signified interest in submitting bids.

BE IT RESOLVED that invitations be made by circular for a period of 30 days, and that the Board of Directors make the award to the most qualified bidder, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Council and the Manager of Fort Apache Timber Company be authorized to execute a contract covering each logging unit with the successful bidder.

The foregoing resolution was on January 16, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
