

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Gayle A. Millet, Construction Manager, has recommended to the Council that he be authorized to negotiate for the sale of certain types of rock and stone on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, if a contract could be effectuated, it would be a benefit to the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Gayle A. Millet, the Construction Manager, be authorized and directed to negotiate with the Apache Stone Company and any other interested parties for the sale of certain types of rock or stone located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Gayle A. Millet report back to the Tribal Council at its general meeting, the results of his negotiations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the U. S. Geological Survey be requested to inspect the rock and stone to be sold and to recommend to the Tribal Council the prices to be charged for said rock and stone.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
